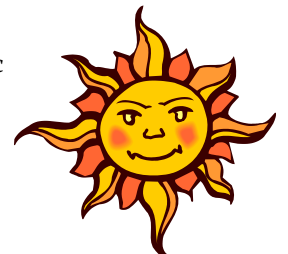
## JUNE NEWS:

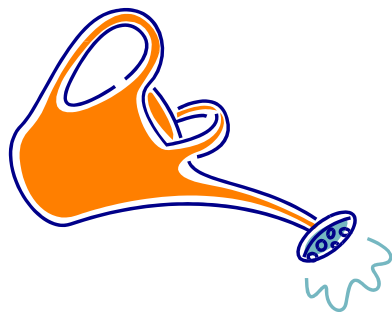
